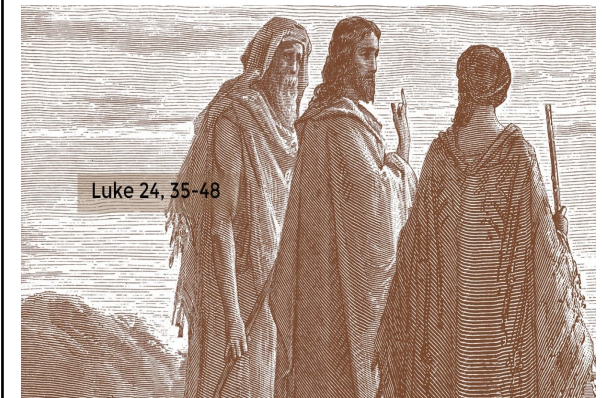

COVID REQUIREMENTS

If you are attending Mass or any other event at
Hallett Cove you are required to Scan the QR
code or sign in. This is a mandatory requirement
by the SA Government.

We are now allowed 3 people per 4m² which
means 335 people in our church. You will still

Emergency Evacuation.

In the event of an emergency, please follow the
directions of the parish priest, reader or
commentator who shall act as the chief warden
and take control of the emergency response. The
collectors shall assist as wardens.

When directed to evacuate the church:

- Move quickly and orderly to the nearest safe
exit, do not run.
- If required, provide assistance to disabled
persons and the elderly.
- Alert the chief warden/warden if someone is
unable or unwilling to evacuate.
- Proceed to the designated assembly area on
the oval or in the carpark beside the church and
await further instructions from the chief warden or
emergency services.
- Do not re-enter the building until advised by the
chief warden or emergency services.

Work Health & Safety Audit

This week we were audited by Catholic WHS. We
managed an 83% compliance, so there are a few
areas that need to be looked at. In the coming
months there may be new procedures being
implemented.
